No prior knowledge of Chinese is required.</p> <p><b>Lab Exchange:</b> This program is intended for undergraduate and graduate students who wish to conduct research under the supervision of an advisor at NCHU. Applicant Qualifications	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Must be a current undergraduate student or a graduate student at Kasetsart University and have completed at least one academic year at the time of the exchange.</li> <li>2. The applicant must have good academic standing.</li> <li>3. Must be in good physical and mental health.</li> </ol>								

	<p>4. The applicant must have good proficiency in English or Chinese (with a minimum English proficiency test score of TOEFL 500 ITP, 61 iBT, IELTS of 5.0, TOEIC 670, or an equivalent test score).</p> <p>5. The applicant must be able to cover the cost of living in Taiwan for the duration of the exchange.</p> <p>. The applicant must maintain student status at Kasetsart University for the entire duration of the exchange and must return to continue their studies at Kasetsart University immediately after the exchange period ends.</p>
<b>Required Documents</b>	<p>Applicants must prepare the following documents and apply through their faculty, along with a nomination letter to the International Affairs Division:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Application for Kasetsart University Exchange Student Program</b> (using the form provided by the International Affairs Division)</li> <li>2. <b>Certificate of Enrollment</b> in English (issued by the Office of Educational Administration)</li> <li>3. <b>Official Transcript</b>, issued from Office of Education Administration</li> <li>4. Two <b>letters of Recommendation</b> in English, issued by an advisor, instructor, head of the department, or dean of the applicant's faculty (one letter each).</li> <li>5. <b>Plan of Study</b> (written in English or Mandarin Chinese), specifying the college and department of interest for the exchange, including reasons and plans for the exchange at NCHU. Applicants for the Lab Exchange program must also specify the name of the laboratory and mentor professor.</li> <li>6. <b>Biography</b>, 300-500 words (typed in English or Mandarin Chinese).</li> <li>7. <b>English or Chinese proficiency test certificate</b> (if available).</li> <li>8. Any additional documents that may support the selection process (if available).</li> </ol> <p><b>Note:</b> Nominated applicants must submit their application documents in the specified form as a WORD file.</p>
<b>Expense</b>	Students will be exempted from tuition fees at NCHU. However, they must cover other expenses such as accommodation (single room, approximately 13,000-14,000 Baht per semester), utilities, food, international and domestic travel, life and health insurance, etc.
<b>Financial Support</b>	Opportunity for consideration for a scholarship from NCHU, subject to the budget and the qualifications of the applicant.
<b>Accommodation</b>	On-Campus dormitory
<b>Deadline</b>	Submit all documents to the International Affairs Division by March 21, 2025.
