Program details	This program is for exchange students to study in classes taught in English or Korean, focusing on subjects related to their current studies. The program includes teaching the Korean language to the exchange students and a buddy program to provide information to international students.

Applicant Qualifications	1. Must be a current undergraduate or a Kasetsart University graduate student.

	<p>2. Must have good proficiency in English or Korean.</p> <p>3. Must maintain a GPA of no less than 2.70.</p> <p>4. Must be able to cover expenses during the exchange programs at KNU.</p> <p>5. Must maintain the student status at Kasetsart University throughout the exchange and return to continue studies immediately after the exchange ends.</p>
Required Documents	<p>Applicants must prepare the following documents and apply through their faculty to the International Affairs Division:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Application for Kasetsart University Exchange Student Program (using the form provided by the International Affairs Division) 2. Study Plan during the program at Kangwon National University, typed in A4 paper and specify the desired College and Department for the program. 3. Certificate of Enrollment in English (one copy, issued by the Office of Educational Administration), the nominated applicants must proceed with certification of the Certificate of Enrollment at the Embassy of the Republic of Korea 4. Official Transcript of Academic Records (one copy, issued by the Office of Educational Administration). 5. Letter of Recommendation in English, issued by the applicant's academic advisor or a main course instructor 6. Bank Certificate of the sponsor in English showing the current balance of the student or guardian. For a one-semester exchange, a minimum balance of 160,000 Baht is required; for a two-semester exchange, a minimum balance of 350,000 Baht is required. 7. Copy of Passport 8. English or Korean Language Proficiency Test Results, if applicable. <p>Note: Nominated applicants must submit their application documents in the specified form as a WORD file.</p>
Expense	<p>Students will be exempted from tuition fees at Kangwon National University. However, they must cover other expenses such as accommodation (shared, 2-4 persons per room, on-campus dormitory costs approximately 14,000-19,000 Baht per semester), utilities, food, international and domestic travel, life and health insurance, etc.</p> <p>Notes: Students who wish to join the 2 semester program must cover their summer break's dormitory expenses themselves, approximately 7,000 – 15,000 Baht.</p>
