Duration	1 semester: September 2025 – January 2026 or 1 academic year: September 2025 – June 2026	
Applicant Qualifications	 Must be a current undergraduate student or a graduate student at Kasetsart University and have completed at least one academic year at the time of the exchange. The applicant must be in good academic standing and meet the minimum requirements set by the respective department of NCKU (details in attached documents). Must be in good physical and mental health. The applicant must have good proficiency in English or Chinese, including speaking, reading, and writing, and meet the minimum test score requirements set by the respective NCKU department (details in attached documents). 	

	5. The applicant must be able to cover the cost of living in Taiwan for the duration of the	
	exchange.	
	6. The applicant must maintain student status at Kasetsart University for the entire	
	duration of the exchange and must return to continue their studies at Kasetsart University	
	immediately after the exchange period ends.	
Required Documents	Applicants must prepare the following documents and apply through their faculty, along	
	with a nomination letter to the International Affairs Division:	
	1. Application for Kasetsart University Exchange Student Program (using the	
	form provided by the International Affairs Division)	
	2. Certificate of Enrollment in English (issued by the Office of Educational	
	Administration)	
	3. Official Transcript, issued from Office of Education Administration	
	4. Letters of Recommendation, at least two, written in English, issued by an	
	advisor, instructor, head of the department, or dean of the applicant's faculty.	
	5. Plan of Study, written in English, specifying the college and department of	
	interest for the exchange, as well as a list of desired courses for the exchange at	
	NCKU.	
	6. Autobiography: includes self-introduction and educational background.	
	7. Language Proficiency Test Results: English or Chinese test scores meeting the	
	minimum requirements set by the respective NCKU department.	
	8. A copy of Passport.	
	9. Chinese ID Copy (if applicable): Copies of both sides of the ID card for Chinese	
	nationals only.	
	10. Financial Statement: An English version issued by a bank or financial institution,	
	demonstrating a current balance of at least 120,000 THB for one academic year	
	or 60,000 THB for one semster	
	Note: Qualified candidates will be contacted by the Office of International Affairs for	
	further instructions regarding the online application process.	
Expense	Tuition fees at NCKU will be waived for selected candidates; however, all other expenses	
	must be covered by the student, including accommodation, food, utilities, international	
	and domestic travel, health, and life insurance	
Accommodation	on-campus dormitories or off-campus private housing, for which students must make their	
	own arrangements if choosing private housing.
