Applicant Qualifications	1. Must be a current undergraduate or a Kasetsart University graduate student.

	<p>2. Have a cumulative GPA of no less than 3.00.</p> <p>3. The applicant must have good proficiency in English or Japanese</p> <p>4. The applicant must Be able to cover the expenses associated with participating in the exchange program according to the conditions set by Sophia University.</p> <p>5. The applicant must maintain student status at Kasetsart University for the entire duration of the exchange and must return to continue their studies at Kasetsart University immediately after the exchange period ends.</p>
Required Documents	<p>Applicants must prepare the following documents and apply through their faculty, along with a nomination letter to the International Affairs Division:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Application for Kasetsart University Exchange Student Program (using the form provided by the International Affairs Division) Study Plan describing the academic plan for the exchange program at Sophia University, printed on A4 paper in English. Language proficiency test results: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For programs taught in English: minimum scores of TOEFL iBT: 79, TOEFL PBT/ITP: 550, IELTS (Academic): 6.0, TOEIC (LR): 730, or Cambridge English: C2 Proficiency (CPE) or C1 Advanced (CAE). For programs taught in Japanese: minimum score of Japanese Language Proficiency Test N1 level. Academic transcript issued by the Office of the Registrar. One Recommendation Letter from an academic advisor or a main course instructor (use the specified form). A current bank statement in the name of the student applicant or the guardian responsible for covering the program expenses (in English), showing a minimum balance of 180,000 THB for one semester or 350,000 THB for two semesters of study. A copy of the passport, valid for at least one year after the end of the exchange program. <p>Note: Students who are nominated by the university will be notified by the International Affairs Division to prepare additional application documents and proceed with the official online application process.</p>
Expense	<p>Students will be exempted from tuition fees at Sophia University, however, they must cover other expenses such as dormitory fees (approximately 80,000-180,000 THB per semester), utilities, food, international and domestic travel, life and health insurance, and other personal expenses.</p>
Deadline	<p>Submit the application through the their faculty along with the nomination letter to the International Affairs Division by March 31, 2025.</p>
