Admission Requirements

- Non-native Thai speakers, including foreigners or Thai nationals who do not use Thai as their first language.
- Must possess a high school certificate or an equivalent qualification.
- Admission through direct interview or a Thai Language Test conducted by TLF-KU (or)
- Admission through the Exchange Student Program with partner universities with an MOU with Kasetsart University (or)
- Admission through international organizations/institutes in consultation with the Department of Thai Language, Faculty of Humanities, and in alignment with the agreements of Kasetsart University.

Curriculum

A minimum of 120 credits across 8 semesters is required. Students may register for up to 22 credits per semester and are expected to study 2 semesters per year.
