1. Program details	<p>1. Japanese Language Skills Development Program: The program courses are taught in Japanese and require a Japanese language proficiency test score of at least N2 (JLPT).</p> <p>2. Foreign Studies – Japanese Program: The applicant will learn basic Japanese language via courses such as Japanese Tourism, Advanced Culture, and Japanese Literature. The program courses are taught in English. Applicants must at least have English proficiency test scores of TOEFL iBT 68, IELTS 5.5, or TOEIC 785 (400 Listening + 385 Reading).</p>

Applicant Qualifications	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be a current undergraduate student at Kasetsart University, at least in their second year. 2. Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75.

	<p>3. Must have good proficiency in English or Japanese, depending on the course:</p> <p>3.1 For the Japanese language skills Development Program, a Japanese language proficiency test score of at least N2 (JLPT) is required.</p> <p>3.12 For the Foreign Studies Program, English proficiency test scores of at least TOEFL iBT 68, IELTS 5.5, or TOEIC 785 (400 Listening + 385 Reading) are required.</p> <p>4. Must be able to cover living expenses in Japan for the entire duration of the exchange program.</p> <p>5. Must maintain student status at Kasetsart University throughout the program and return to continue studies at Kasetsart University immediately after the program ends.</p>
Required Documents	<p>Applicants must prepare the following documents along with a nomination letter from their faculty to the International Affairs Division:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Application for Kasetsart University Exchange Student Program (using the form provided by the International Affairs Division) 2. Letter of Recommendation in English, issued by the applicant's academic advisor or a main course instructor 3. Study Plan in English, explaining the study plan for the exchange program at Meijo University 4. Official Transcript of Academic Records (one copy) 5. Language Proficiency Test Results as required by each program 6. Certificate of Student Status in English (one copy, issued by the Office of Educational Administration) 7. Copy of Passport 8. Statement of Bank Account Balance in English (one page), showing the current balance of the student or guardian. For a one-semester exchange, a minimum balance of 150,000 baht is required; for a two-semester exchange, a minimum balance of 300,000 baht is required. <p>Note: Selected applicants for Meijo University must complete an additional online application, details of which will be provided directly by the International Affairs Division.</p>
Expense	<p>Selected applicants will be exempted from tuition fees at Meijo University. However, they must cover other expenses such as international airfare, accommodation (approximately 25,000 yen per month), food, domestic travel in Japan, life and health insurance, etc. The average cost of living in Japan is about 80,000 - 100,000 Yen per month (approximately 20,000 - 25,000 Baht).</p>
Financial Support	<p>There is an opportunity to apply for financial assistance from Meijo University, amounting to 25,000 yen per month (approximately 6,000 baht). Note: Applicants must primarily be able to cover their own expenses, as the scholarship amount is limited.</p>
Deadline	<p>The documents must be submitted to the International Affairs Division by February 20, 2025.</p>
