Program details	<p>For undergraduate or master's students who wish to participate in an exchange program at Shizuoka University in a field related to their current studies. Applicants must have excellent skills in the Japanese language because the majority of the courses at Shizuoka University are taught in Japanese.</p> <p>In cases where the applicant's Japanese language proficiency test results are not at the level required to attend regular classes, Shizuoka University will consider placing the applicant in language and culture classes and/or courses that are suitable for the applicant's language level.</p>

Applicant Qualifications	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be a current undergraduate student in their second year or higher or a graduate student at Kasetsart University. 2. Must have good proficiency in Japanese and English. (JLPT Level 1-2). In cases where the applicant's Japanese language proficiency test results are not at the level required to attend regular classes, Shizuoka University will consider placing the applicant in language and culture classes and/or courses that are suitable for the applicant's language level. 3. Must be in good physical and mental health. 4. Must be able to cover expenses during the exchange at Shizuoka University. 5. Must maintain the student status at Kasetsart University throughout the exchange and return to continue studies immediately after the exchange ends.
Required Documents	<p>Applicants must prepare the following documents and apply through their faculty to the International Affairs Division:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Application for Kasetsart University Exchange Student Program (using the form provided by the International Affairs Division) 2. Study Plan in English, typed in A4 paper. 3. Letter of Recommendation, at least one from the applicant's advisor/Head of the department, or Dean. 4. Official Transcript, issued from Office of Education Administration 5. Certificate of Enrollment in English (issued by the Office of Educational Administration) 6. Proof of Financial Status of the applicant or sponsor, in English or Japanese, according to the exchange duration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5.1 for one semester: minimum 150,000 baht 5.2 for two semesters: minimum 300,000 baht 7. Copy of Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) 8. Clear Copy of Passport <p>Note: Nominated applicants must submit their application documents in the specified form as a WORD file.</p>
Expense	<p>Students will be exempted from tuition fees at Shizuoka University. However, they must cover other expenses such as accommodation (single room, approximately 1,500-2,000 Baht per month), utilities, food, international and domestic travel, life and health insurance, etc. The cost of living in Japan is approximately 80,000-100,000 Yen per month (about 20,000-30,000 Baht).</p>
