Applicant Qualifications	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Must be a current undergraduate or graduate student at Kasetsart University and have completed at least one year of study at the time of exchange.</li> <li>2. Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.50.</li> <li>3. Must be in good physical and mental health.</li> <li>4. Must have good proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing English or Chinese. For courses taught in English, applicants should have at least an English proficiency test score of TOEFL (IBT) 79, IELTS 6.0, or an equivalent test score.</li> <li>5. Must be able to cover living expenses in Taiwan for the entire duration of the exchange.</li> <li>6. Must maintain student status at Kasetsart University throughout the exchange and return to continue studies at Kasetsart University immediately after the exchange ends.</li> </ol>
Required Documents	<p>Applicants must prepare the following documents and apply through their faculty with a nomination letter to the International Affairs Division:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Application for Kasetsart University Exchange Student Program</b> (using the form provided by the International Affairs Division)</li> <li>2. <b>Certificate of Enrollment</b> in English (issued by the Office of Educational Administration)</li> <li>3. <b>Official Transcript</b> in English (issued by the Office of Educational Administration)</li> <li>4. <b>Letter of Recommendation</b> in English (one copy) issued by the academic advisor, course instructor, head of the department, or dean of the applicant's home faculty</li> <li>5. <b>Study Plan</b> (written in English or Mandarin Chinese) stating the College and Department of interest, along with the reasons and plan for the exchange at NTHU</li> <li>6. <b>Language Proficiency Test Results for English or Chinese</b> (see details in the attached Language Proficiency requirement)</li> </ol> <p><b>Note:</b> The International Affairs Division will contact nominated applicants to proceed with the online application.</p>
Expense	Selected students will be exempted from tuition fees at NTHU. However, they must cover other expenses themselves, such as accommodation, food, utilities, international and domestic travel, and life and health insurance.
