| Program details | This program is open to undergraduate and graduate students who wish to participate in exchange programs in fields related to their current studies. Applicants must possess a high proficiency in Japanese (JLPT N1-N2) as most courses at Wakayama University are taught in Japanese. Exceptions apply to the Faculty of Tourism, which offers courses in English. For the Japanese Language Course, applicants without JLPT N2 certification must provide equivalent proficiency verification issued by their home university's Japanese language instructor, along with a JLPT N3 certificate. |

The applicant must be a current undergraduate student (at least in their second year) or a graduate student at Kasetsart University. 2. The applicant must have a high level of Japanese proficiency (JLPT N1-N2). For applicants to the Faculty of Tourism, submission of an IELTS score sheet is required. 3. The applicant must be in good physical and mental health. 4. The applicant must be capable of covering all expenses incurred during the exchange program at Wakayama University. 5. The applicant must maintain student status at Kasetsart University for the entire duration of the exchange and must return to continue their studies at Kasetsart University immediately after the exchange period ends. |
| Required Documents | Applicants must prepare the following documents and apply through their faculty, along with a nomination letter to the International Affairs Division: |

| Expense | Students will be exempted from tuition fees at Wakayama University, however, they must cover other expenses such as accommodation, meals, international and domestic travel, and health and life insurance. The estimated cost of living in Japan is approximately 80,000 – 100,000 JPY per month (approximately 20,000–30,000 THB). |
| Deadline | Submit the application through their faculty to the International Affairs Division by March 31, 2025. |
